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MOBILITY CORRIDOR DESCRIPTIONS

The following table provides planning criteria for the ultimate build out of the proposed Mobility Corridors. Interim access control and speed limits may be applied by the local responsible jurisdiction until such time (as determined by the local jurisdiction) that a corridor transitions to its intended future function.

CORRIDOR CLASS	CORRIDOR SPEED	CORRIDOR R/W WIDTH	CORRIDOR ACCESS CONTROL
Class I	60 to 65 MPH	200 feet (additional required at future interchange locations)	Interchanges at two mile spacing – no direct parcel access
Class II	50 to 55 MPH	130 feet (additional may be required at intersections)	Intersections at one mile spacing – no direct parcel access
Class III	40 to 45 MPH	130 feet (additional may be required at intersections)	Intersections at one-half mile spacing – no direct parcel access
