Provide a brief summary of the basis for criterion selection listed above (the necessary content for a supportive basis statement is provided under the criterion you selected.):

The US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) Information for Planning and Conservation (IPaC) database was reviewed to identify potential endangered species within the project area. The system was accessed, and a report generated on March 20, 2017. The Slickspot peppergrass (*lepidium papilliferum*) is listed as the only threatened species. Slickspot peppergrass is generally found within the sagebrush habitat community. The project area has been severely disturbed with farming activities, that the sage brush and Slickspot peppergrass habitat is not within the project area. Due to the nature of the project no adverse impact is anticipated.

What federally-listed species or federally-designated critical habitat are located in your "action area"?

N/A - Slickspot peppergrass was listed as a possibility, however do to the high land disturbance of historical farming activities the action area does not provide the appropriate habitat.
